

# Official Rules and Regulations



1. Presented by the Health and Wellness Foundation on behalf of Catholic Health Initiatives, a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation in support of its sister healthcare ministry, the Indigenous People's Hospital in the Philippines.
2. Numbered rubber ducks will be launched near the confluence of the Otter Tail and Bois de Sioux rivers, which form the headwaters of the Red River of the North, at approximately 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 10, 2011. Weather conditions or other interference may affect race time. The racecourse will be established by the Presenter and will end near Welles Memorial Park in the Breckenridge-Wahpeton area. The Presenter reserves the right to manually maneuver ducks while on the racecourse. If extreme circumstances prevent the race from occurring on September 10, 2011, winners will be determined by a random drawing conducted by the Presenter within one week. Presenter shall not be held liable for any loss, damage or inconvenience.
3. All ducks entered will be provided by the Presenter and shall remain the property of the Presenter.
4. Once ducks are launched, they are on their own. No attempt to free or interfere with any duck is permitted.
5. A number is written on each duck corresponding to a number on each entry ticket. Prizes will be awarded to the entrants whose names appear on the three tickets corresponding to the first three ducks to cross the finish line and/or are retrieved from the duck trap in the order of finish.
6. The combined value of the prizes is \$3,000. Chances of winning will depend on the total number of qualified entrants.
7. Entries will not be accepted after 12:45 p.m. on September 10, 2011. The Presenter reserves the right to limit the number of entries.
8. Entrants need not be present to win. Winners will be announced. Winners will, where necessary, be notified by telephone or US mail. If a winner does not claim his/her prize within 30 days after September 10, 2011, Presenter will select a winner by random drawing of entry tickets. All prizes will be awarded. Claimants must be 18 years of age and must prove eligibility with positive identification (valid driver's license). Any and all taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner.
9. In order to maximize proceeds, no one, except the Race Judges, is ineligible from participating in the Ducky Derby. The Presenter asserts the validity and integrity of the event, and welcomes anyone to witness the race and the arbitrary chance of any duck winning.
10. The Race Judges, appointed by the Presenter, will make all decisions and interpretations of the rules and regulations and their judgment is final.
11. By entering, entrants release Presenter and its officers, directors and staff, and other related entities from any and all liability, and consent to the promotion of their names and likenesses without additional compensation.
12. This event is subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations.
